Our deepest fear is not that we are inadequate. Our deepest fear is that we are powerful beyond measure. It is our light, not our darkness that most frightens us. We ask ourselves, Who am I to be brilliant, gorgeous, talented, and fabulous? Actually, who are you not to be? You are a child of God. Your playing small does not serve the world. There is nothing enlightened about shrinking so that other people will not feel insecure around you. We are all meant to shine, as children do. We were born to make manifest the glory of God that is within us. It is not just in some of us; it is in everyone and as we let our own light shine. we unconsciously give others permission to do the same. As we are liberated from our own fear, our presence automatically liberates others.

In Hans Christian Andersen's story, 'The Ugly Duckling', the poor duckling does not meet the expectations of the ducks around him. One day he sees some graceful swans with their glorious wings and dazzling white plumage. He is attracted by their beauty and he has a sense of being a greater self than he or others ever suspected. Initially, this is only a fleeting awareness and soon he is caught up in the hard struggle for survival as a long winter sets in. It is only when the warm sun of Spring replaces the Winter cold and he sees his reflection in still water that he realises that he, too, is a beautiful swan.

We are afraid to believe in our own greatness. We are afraid of the unknown. Or perhaps it is more true to say that we are afraid of losing the known. The limits of our vision are the limits of our world. A vision is not just a picture of what could be ours; it is an appeal to our better selves, a call to becoming something more.
