As we've come to the end of Pride Month, the annual celebration of identity which takes place during the month of June, it's crucial that we maintain the momentum of acceptance, support and love for marginalised groups of our community, particularly those who may feel excluded from the Church. In the spirit of this, I'd like to extend a friendly invitation to join me in celebrating and supporting LGBT+ people at the Parishes of St. Agnes and St. Aidan's Social Group. This will aim to provide a safe and all-encompassing space for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans and other members of our Parish community, family and friends. I want to emphasise that there is absolutely no criteria or checklist to meet in order to join the Group: whether or not you are part of the Church, the LGBT+ community or an ally, everybody is welcome at our table.

Following the negative response issued by the Vatican Congregation for Doctrine of the Faith to the question about blessing same-sex relationships in March, as well as recent homophobic attacks across Liverpool, I feel it's important to let you know that the Group will be an open and safe space for members and allies of the LGBT+ community to express their authentic identities and share their experiences in fullness and safety. The Parishes of St. Agnes and St. Aidan stand with its LGBT+ children, grandchildren, brothers, sisters, uncles, aunts, parents, grandparents, cousins and friends, and the Vatican's statement does not at all reflect the pastoral reality of our Parish community. Committed to loving and supporting all walks of life, Fr. Anton, Fr. Richard, the sisters, deacons and pastoral team have been such a blessing during this turbulent moment in our journey of faith. I am so proud and honoured to be given this opportunity to use the Parishes as a safe environment for LGBT+ people and people of faith to come together, and wish to share this with as many people as I can reach.

The Group will gather bi-monthly on a Sunday evening, with the first few gatherings occurring on 25th July, 8th August and 22nd August at 6pm in the Sister Elizabeth Kelly Room at St. Agnes RC Church, 82 Hey Road, Huyton, L36 5SQ. There's absolutely no pressure to stay for the whole time or attend every meet-up, as everybody is welcome to come for as long or as often as they feel comfortable and able to, but feel free to drop in and see some familiar faces sharing their experiences, consoling and educating each other about what it means to be part of the LGBT+ community.
