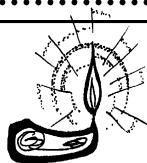

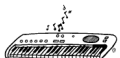
### Fourth Dimension Shop

Friday 27<sup>th</sup> January is Holocaust memorial day. The theme this year is *'Speak Up, Speak Out'*. The poem above, written ring the Holocaust, highlights the dangers of not speaking our when we experience, see or hear injustice.

Everyone should have a fundamental Human Right to freedom of speech. Each of us has a voice and the choice to use it. The choices we make in the words and language we use every day contribute to creating a fair and safe society. Holocaust Memorial Day reminds us however that voices continue to be ignored or silenced. Long after the Holocaust of the Nazi regime, genocide took place in Cambodia, Rwanda, Armenia, Bosnia and Darfur. And there are countless current examples of people who need our voice: refugees, the poor, the disabled, those with learning difficulties, carers, trafficked people caught in the sex trade or domestic servitude...

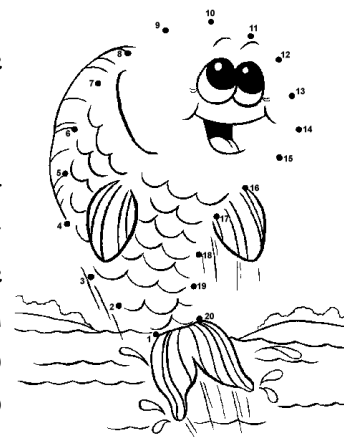
Today as much as ever we need to *'Speak Up, Speak Out'* and we have the opportunity to do so in many ways. As well as telling others our opinion, we can start or join social media campaigns, write to those in power, organise or join demonstrations and protests to support what we believe in, challenge the use, even by our children, of terms like 'gay' or 'Jew' as a derogatory term of offence. While in some parts of the world, speaking out can still bring torture or death, for us there are many things we can do simply and easily – don't we have a duty to do so?
