
Donations of good quality clothes can be left at the back of either church after Mass or handed in to the office.



The Christ, the Anointed One

Jesus asks the question, "Who do *you* say that I am?" and Peter replies, "You are the Christ" Perhaps we want to ask the question, "What does Peter mean by naming Jesus as 'the Christ'?"

Christ is not Jesus' last name. The word *Christ* is a title, meaning the Anointed One, and that anointment by God includes us and all of creation. We so consistently applied 'Christ' to Jesus that it has become like a religious name.

The Cosmic Christ is Divine Presence pervading all of creation since the very beginning. When we believe in Jesus Christ, we're believing in something much bigger than just the historical incarnation that we call Jesus. Jesus is just the visible map. The entire sweep of the meaning of the Anointed One, the Christ, includes us and includes all of creation since the beginning of time.

Wherever the human and the divine coexist, we have the Christ. Wherever the material and the spiritual coincide, we have the Christ. That includes the material world, the natural world, the animal world (including humans), and moves all the way to the elemental world, symbolized by bread and wine. "Eat it and know who you are," St. Augustine said. You are what you drink and eat, as any good nutritionist will tell you.

It has been said that when Jesus said to Peter, "Upon this rock I will build my church", he is referring to Peter's <u>faith</u> and his understanding of the Christ Mystery which is much bigger than Christianity as an organized religion. Jesus did not come to create a country club or a tribe of people who could say, "We're in and you're out. We've got the truth and you don't." Jesus came to reveal something that was true everywhere, for everyone, and all the time. The entire sweep of the meaning of the Anointed One, the Christ, includes us and includes all of creation since the beginning of time. When we understand this, matter itself becomes a holy thing. We worship God by walking with love and respect on this planet and with all other creatures. What a simple, universal, and wholehearted religion this would be!
