Quiet During Services

It is a strength of our parish communities that we are friendly and welcoming. We do need to be aware however that during the Mass, we are in the presence of Christ in a special way. Please help us to create a quiet, respectful, and prayerful atmosphere during services in both churches.

Let the light of God's love shine

Relationships with one another are based on trust or lack of it. To grow in love, in friendship, in working relationships we have to allow others to trust us and be prepared to place our trust in them. Speaking to a lady recently about her life and her marriage break up she said: because she trusted her husband so much, when he had an affair she could never trust him again. He had broken her trust and in the process had ended their relationship and fractured the love that had brought them to marriage in the first place.

To trust, to place one's confidence in someone else is about having 'faith' in them, depending on their reliability, exposing oneself to their honesty and sincerity. Trust embraces so many other virtues and qualities in life - love, honesty, sincerity and truth.

In the Gospel the man places his trust in his three servants and trusts them completely according to their ability - he recognises that not everyone is the same so he doesn't overburden any of them. The man is not looking for perfection but for honesty and effort that his servants would do their best to reward him for his trust. Two fulfil his trust but the third, the man with one talent, allows his fears to restrict his progress and growth. He was afraid to take a risk, to trust in his own ability or the support of others.

Fear can prevent us from becoming the people that God wants us to be. Fear of failure, fear of getting it wrong, fear of what others may say, fear of being exposed as the real me can imprison us, keep us in the dark and never allow the light of God's love to shine on me and in me. In the Gospels the people whom Jesus most admires are the ones who have made mistakes and learnt from them to become better people.

Society in general, local communities and families in particular are less and less exposed to the presence and love of God today. People of faith who are gifted and completely trusted by God need to be the risk takers, to be witnesses no matter what the cost, so that others will also experience something of the real love of God. The prize will be inner peace knowing that I have honoured the trust and confidence God has placed in me.
