STAGGS

At last we have broken the back of the ivy and there is very little of it left around the main lawn area. We have re-defined the pathway around the perimeter and have re-built some of the stone walling. We have also had quotes for the tree removal program and this will involve removing all of the trees from the main car park perimeter wall before they become more of a problem with the perimeter walling and removal / lopping of trees from around the garden walls. We are also having the ivy taken off the remaining trees. The chippings from the trees will form the surface of the pathway. We expect to be able to start on the smaller lawn areas in the next few weeks.

We hope to begin planting in the next few weeks so any donations of shrubs, perennials and annual plants would be gratefully received.
