It is the smallest of all the seeds; yet it grows into the biggest shrub of them all.

"What can we say the kingdom of God is like? What parable can we find for it? It is like a mustard seed..." Mark 4

Today's Gospel tells us that the kingdom of God is like the smallest of all the seeds, the smallest of all the seeds that will grow into the biggest shrub. Jesus presents an image of what he expects his work to produce. For those of us who have watched plants grow from seeds, the process is slow, steady and mostly unseen. It happens underground, undercover and hidden from view. "The seed is sprouting and growing; how, we do not know." Yet, once in bloom, we are able to experience the surprising beauty of the flower.

Jesus suggests to us that the kingdom of God will grow in a similar way. It may be a slow process, it may be mostly unseen, but it will be a steady process of growth. It will grow from the small acts of kindness, from the reaching out of one person to another, from the smile extended to a stranger. It will grow from the **little** things done with love.

We are challenged to plant our own mustard seeds that will contribute to the growth of God's kingdom. We are challenged to go forward and express love through our everyday actions. We are challenged to show acts of kindness however big or small and in doing so we will experience and be one with the growth of the kingdom of God.
